

Introduction

Congratulations on your selection of the CASIO TK-1100 electronic cash register. This ECR is the product of the world's most advanced electronic technology, for outstanding versatility and reliability. Simplified operation is made possible by a specially designed keyboard layout and a wide selection of automated, programmable functions.

A specially designed keyboard layout and a bright, easy-to-read display help to take the fatigue out of long hours of operation.

Important

Your new cash register has been carefully tested before shipment to ensure proper operation. Safety devices eliminate worries about breakdowns resulting from operator errors or improper handling. In order to ensure years of trouble-free operation, however, the following points should be noted when handling the cash register.

Location

Do not locate the cash register near a heater or in areas exposed to direct sunlight, humidity or dust. Locate the cash register on a flat, stable surface.

•Power Cord

The cash register operates on standard household current (120, 220, 230, 240V: 50/60Hz). Do not use an overloaded outlet and be sure that the cord is located where no one will trip over it.

•Cleaning

Clean the exterior of the cash register with a soft cloth which has been dipped in a mild detergent solution and wrung out. Be sure that the cloth is thoroughly wrung out to avoid damage to the printer. Never use paint thinner, benzine, or other volatile solvents.
