1. SCOPE

This specification applies to the key operations for the keys and the display panel of the B-472-QQ and B-472-QP General-purpose Thermal Label/Tag Printers.

2. OUTLINE

Keyboard operations are roughly classified into the online mode in which a pause/restart is carried out and error messages are displayed, and the system mode in which self-test and setting of various parameters are performed.

This specification describes the key operation procedures for the printer keys and the LCD panel.
